#### Our school initiatives which are on track to meet or exceed our targets

During 2017, we focused on maximising the benefits of this funding for our students. After reviewing our 2017 *Investing for Success* agreement, it is clear that we are on track to meet or exceed our targeted student outcomes. We continue to implement our initiatives to ensure that every student succeeds.

Initiatives implemented include:

- Development of a Miles State High School 2017-2020 STEM Strategy that underpins a professional learning culture to increase student engagement in STEM.
- Increased students participating in STEM related activities through engagement in class and co-curricular industry and tertiary opportunities.
- Development and implementation of Digital Technologies as an elective in Year 9/10
- 100% of 2017 Year 12 attain a QCE or QCIA
- Increased % of Year 12 Students obtaining an OP 1-15

#### Our school initiatives which are showing substantial progress toward our targets

After reviewing our 2017 Investing for Success agreement, it is clear that we have made progress toward our targeted student outcomes. We will continue to focus on maximising the benefits of this funding for our students, and adjust our initiatives as needed to ensure every student succeeds.

Initiatives implemented include:

- Increased % A-C attainment of students in Years 7-12 across all KLA's
- Increased % A-B attainment of students in Years 7-12 in English, Maths and Science
- Students with literacy and numeracy skills below NMS routinely engaged in individualised online literacy and numeracy skill enhancement programs.
- Development and implementation of 'Personalised Learning Plans' for all students currently below NMS in Years 7-10 in literacy and numeracy.
- Development of a Miles State High School Writing Strategy. A whole school documented plan that supports the development of writing across all year levels in all KLA's to commence Semester 2 2017.
